4/12/20 PLANNING APPLICATION UPDATE. Information shared.

5/12/20.PLANNING APPLICATION. N/133/02067/20. PROSPECT HOUSE. STATION ROAD NORTH THORESBY.DN365Q. Extension to existing detached garage to form carport/covered way.

Councillors are concerned that no site meeting has been carried out as agree earlier in the year. Parish discussed the consideration of altering existing garage roofline to a flat roof along with a reduction in length of the new application to accommodate the needs of the applicant and concerns raised by the neighbour regarding loss of enjoyment from the property, and suggest comments go to Committee. **OBJECTIONS.**
